What to Bring?	DO NOT bring the following items to camp?
<ul style="list-style-type: none">✿ Alarm Clock✿ Clothes – change of clothes for 7 days (Please refer to California 4-H Dress Code to make sure clothing is appropriate)✿ Fishing equipment and bait, if desired.✿ Flashlight with batteries✿ Disposable Camera✿ Pocket Knives (Are only allowed for fishing, hiking and woodcarving) Knives will be collected at check-in and labeled with your name and checked out to the camp participant as needed.✿ Insect repellent✿ Linens – sleeping bag or sheets & blanket, bath towels, and pillow✿ Musical Instrument, if desired.✿ Plastic bag – for wet clothing, shoes and dirty clothes.✿ Shoes – 1 pair for hiking, 1 pair for sports/activities and a pair of tennis shoes. (No sandals or open-toed shoes allowed at camp)✿ Bring an extra pair of tennis shoes for water sports.✿ Swim suit – (you will likely swim each day_. A cover-up and shoes are required when you walk to and from the pool area) (No speedos allowed)✿ Toietries – soap, deodorant, toothpaste, toothbrush, hairbrush, etc.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">✿ Candy✿ Expensive Jewelry✿ IPods or music listening devices (Camp is not responsible for lost or stolen equipment)✿ Cell phones or pagers✿ Firecrackers✿ Food✿ Gum✿ Playing cards✿ Guns or weapons✿ No pocket knives allowed in cabins (must be checked in at camp registration)✿ Paint Ball Guns✿ Radios✿ Shaving Cream✿ Water Balloons or Water Guns✿ Silly String✿ Skateboards or Rollerblades✿ Tobacco Products
