What to Bring?

- *** Alarm Clock**
- Clothes change of clothes for 7 days (Please refer to California 4-H Dress Code to make sure clothing is appropriate)
- Fishing equipment and bait, if desired.
- **Flashlight with batteries**
- *** Disposable Camera**
- ** Pocket Knives (Are only allowed for fishing, hiking and woodcarving) Knives will be collected at check-in and labeled with your name and checked out to the camp participant as needed.
- *** Insect repellent**
